Fleet Captain's Report

NEW 6 knot speed limit in the area of the Bay Bridge during the construction period.

Mariners should be aware that Aberdeen Test Center is conducting live fire exercises and operational testing of various watercraft through October 1, 2023.

The operation area includes:

Entering the water near Bear Point, proceeding Southeast towards APG K Buoy,


Southward along the restricted APG Water Boundary to H Buoy, Westward to the mouth of Delph Creek and then returning to the Bear Point area.

The watercraft will be accompanied by ATC Patrol boats to provide escort and ensure area is clear of public boats.

All commercial fishing to include placement of crab pots in this area is prohibited during these exercises.

At the same period of time two captured Russian main battle tanks have arrived at APG. Accordingly the secure area has been expanded to include the area from Sparrows Point, 39 deg 22 min, 76 deg 27 min to Sandy Point, 39 deg 27 min, 76 deg 07 min. My suggestion is to stay on the eastern side of the bay.



ADDITONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE PARK

Main Pavilion/Main Picnic Center Seats/Tables: There are **6 eight-foot picnic tables inside**. There are several picnic tables scattered outside the pavilions which can be used as well. 30-40 people can fit inside comfortably.

Note: the park does not allow alcoholic beverages

Charcoal Grills: Yes, there are charcoal grills nearby. You must provide your own charcoal. Includes: electricity, cold water spigot access, picnic tables Handicapped Access: Yes Fireplace: Yes, wood is provided. (Please do not bring firewood with you.)

Restrooms: Yes, flush toilets are attached to one end of the pavilion.

Parking: There are only a few spaces near the pavilion, however, there are parking lots within walking distance.

America's Boating Channel Reminder:

Knowledge of the Navigation Rules Helps Prevent Boating Accidents

As we enter the height of the boating season, don't forget that knowledge of the rules of navigation helps prevent boating accidents. If you need a refresher before getting out on the water, you can access an invaluable library of videos produced by America's Boating Channel. These videos are available to USPS members to view and download for free at bit. ly/USPSABC. There is an index to help you find exactly what you need, which is very convenient for instructors who want to use these videos in the classroom without the need for an internet connection.



For example, Season Four's "Behavioral Consequences" (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yWq-jshx8yU&t=44s) video covers the importance to recreational boat operators of having a working knowledge of the navigation rules. Viewers learn about the dangers of not following the rules of the road. Also featured are tips for responsible boating. Boating responsibly can lead to lasting memories, while bad boating behaviors can cause issues ranging from mere embarrassment to major catastrophe.



America's Boating Channel™ produced a sequel to this video in Season Five titled "Collision Avoidance" (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7cXv6s7wqjE&t=1s), which covers the most basic and essential navigation rules. Viewers learn how to determine stand-on and give-

way vessels in various circumstances. It also features tips for steering clear of potentially dangerous situations. For example, at night not using navigation lights or not learning how to interpret them can lead to incidents with more serious outcomes than during the day. Again, these two videos are good refreshers before visiting your local waterway at a time of year when it will be most crowded.
